



BIO DATA OF HON'BLE MR JUSTICE N K SUD

Born on 3rd June 1944 Justice Narinder Kumar Sud originally belongs to district Kangra now in Himachal Pradesh. He graduated from D.A.V. College Jalandhar with honors in economics and was placed second in the university in the year 1963. Thereafter, he did his law from Punjab University Law College Chandigarh in 1965 and was once again placed second in the university. Besides a good academic record he took keen interest in extra-curricular activities; he was the best debater of the Punjab University Law College, Chandigarh, from 1963 to 1965. In 1965 he was enrolled as an advocate and he joined his father in the legal profession. His specialization was Direct Taxes. His professional competence was recognized in 1982 when he was appointed a judicial Member of the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal; he however could not accept this position due to his family circumstances. Ultimately, he was elevated as a judge of Punjab and Haryana High Court in May, 1999.

Besides being a successful professional, he has been active in social and educational fields as well. He was actively associated with Indian Junior Chamber, an individual development organization and Rotary International, a service organization. He joined Rotary International in the year 1985 and was the charter president of the Rotary Club of Jalandhar Central. After holding various positions in the District 3070, he was unanimously elected the District Governor in the year 1997-98.

He was also associated with the managements of prestigious educational institutions of Jalandhar.

He has also been the President of the Jalandhar Income Tax Bar Association for three consecutive years.
